

DRESS CODE

Basic Belief

A school uniform gives a child a sense of belonging and pride in his/her school. It contributes to the maintenance of a good school tone. The uniform is designed in the interests of sun and playground safety, school tone and health reasons.

Guidelines

1. The wearing of school uniform is compulsory.
2. Students are required to wear a uniform sun-smart approved hat whenever they are outside in Terms 1 and 4.
3. School shoes, sport shoes or sandals that support foot development are appropriate daily footwear. Backless shoes are not recommended for school use.
4. Specialised footwear should only be worn during organised special events.
5. The naming of the article shall be the only writing visible on any uniform item.
6. Make-up, including nail polish, is not permitted.
7. Watches, earrings such as sleepers/studs and medical ID bracelets are the only permitted jewellery.
8. The school can be contacted if support in providing school uniforms is required.
9. Any article of clothing deemed to be inappropriate or offensive is not permitted (this includes language or graphics on clothes, as well as garment style). Badly damaged uniforms are also not appropriate.
10. Basis of Discretion – the Principal may be contacted in regards to school uniform issues.
