Family Relationship Centre (FRC)

The FRC assists families affected by separation to come to child focused parenting arrangements in the best interests of their children. Families are supported in discussing issues and reaching agreement through family dispute resolution rather than having to attend court.

Property Dispute Resolution is also offered as an alternative to the court process to resolve property settlements.

Parenting Orders Program (POP)

The Parenting Orders Program uses case management and therapeutic group work to provide assistance to separated parents, and their children, who are experiencing high conflict. It focuses on communication and conflict management skills and requires parents to commit to addressing their differences and focus on the best interests of their children.

Children's Contact Service (CCS)

The Children's Contact Service enables children of separated families to re-establish or maintain contact with both parents or other family members where appropriate. It provides a safe, neutral and child-friendly environment for facilitated contact visits and change-overs.

Regional Family Dispute Resolution (RFDR)

Offers families Dispute Resolution and Family Counselling sessions for issues related to separation and conflict.
